

1. **Spinal Anaesthesia:** Refractory hypotension after SAB for LSCS
2. **General Anaesthesia:** Desaturation during GA for C-Section
3. **Massive Obstetric Haemorrhage:** be prepared to tackle
4. **Acute shortness of Breath** in a term parturient- ABCs
5. **Epidural:** Case scenario of problematic labour epidural.
6. **Maternal Cardiac Arrest** – what is different
