GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACTS

- Abstract must not exceed 300 words excluding the title and authors' name.
- All abstracts must be submitted electronically to aoahyderabad2015@gmail.com
- Abstracts must be in MS word format, 11 point size, Calibri font on a single page.
- Write clearly the title, the names of authors and the name of the institute.
- Underline the name of the presenting author. Do not include degrees or designation.
- Abstract should be structured to include Background, Aims, Methods, Results and Conclusion.
- Graphs, illustrations and diagrams are not permitted within the abstract.

CHARMINAR

MECCA MASJID

About few meters away from the Charminar, this mosque is one of the biggest mosques in the world. This mosque is said to accommodate upto 10,000 worshipers at a time

SALAR JUNG MUSEUM

India's third largest museum, inspired by Mir Yusuf Ali Khan Salar Jung III, is said to have the largest one-man collection of antiques in the world. This museum displays about 45,000 exhibits from all parts of the world.

GOLCONDA FORT


The historic Golconda Fort lies 11 kilometers west of the city. It is one of the most renowned and historical fort complexes in India. The fort stands atop a hill with an elevation of 120 feet. This historical structure was founded originally in the 13th century by the Kakatiyas and later constructed by the Qutub Shahi kings from 1525 AD over a span of 62 years into a massive fort of granite extending over 5 square kilometers.

QUTUB SHAHI TOMBS

The famous tombs of the seven Qutub Shahi rulers are located 1 kilometer from the Golkonda Fort. No where in the world are there so many tombs (more than 20 tombs) at one place as here. All, except the last, of the **Qutub Shahi Sultans** lie buried here. In addition to these, many other tombs of the Royal family members are also seen here..These tombs famously known as 'Seven Tombs', are truly magnificent monuments

HUSSAIN SAGAR

This beautiful artificial lake, popularly known as Tankbund, is located in the heart of the city. Major attraction of the lake is the 18 meter tall, 350 tonne gigantic monolithic statue of Lord Buddha standing amidst the lake. Surrounding the lake are numerous parks and a host of other tourist attractions.

BIRLA MANDIR

Lord Balaji temple built by the Birlas on a hillock close to Tankbund. The temple is a quarter century old and built of white marble.

RAMOJI FILM CITY

RFC is the world's largest integrated film studio complex over 2,000 acres of land. It is also a popular tourism and recreation centre, containing both natural and artificial attractions including an amusement park.

ROADWAYS:


The city has a well developed road network with National Highway No. 7 passing through the city. On the crossroads of National highways 7 and 9, Hydrabad is well connected.
